


UGANDA REPTILES VILLAGE

Conserving for future generation

Uganda Reptiles Village (URV) is a Community Based Organisation that was formed in 2003 by a group of community youth within Bunono Village in Entebbe, who had a passion to Conserve the endangered reptiles within Uganda's ecosystem.

After a serious observation they realised that many Ugandans are not aware of reptiles and their great importance to the development of our country.

Communities being unaware of the importance of reptiles and environment at large is a great danger to the reptiles themselves and this led to the birth of Uganda Reptiles Village (URV).

We have been rescuing and rehabilitating injured and confiscated reptiles, in addition to conduct research to the resident reptiles at the centre.

URV is the first of its kind in Uganda and currently has opened up its office in Bunono Village, Entebbe in Wakiso District

VISION

A community that can protect reptiles and conserve the environment, mainly forests, swamps and water bodies for healthy habitat to reptiles and fight against the extinction of reptiles from earth.
